BARNARD COLLEGE INCUNABULAR RECORDS, 1889 to 1904

Scope and Content Note

Barnard College Incunabular Records, 1889 to 1904 document the first 15 years of Barnard College history, from the college's birth in 1889 as an experiment in women's higher education without the benefit of an endowment, to the years immediately following the attainment of an independent faculty under the intercorporate agreement consummated with Columbia University in 1900.

The collection is comprised of two record groups. Group 1, Files A-O, is arranged according to an antiquated scheme described in Appendix 1. Group 2, consisting of correspondence addressed to any of various administrators (especially the dean) of Barnard College, is arranged in four series, according to the authorship of the letters:

- A. Trustees' Correspondence, 1889 to 1904
- B. Administrators' Correspondence, 1889 to 1904
- C. Faculty Correspondence, 1889 to 1904
- D. General Correspondence, 1889 to 1904

Authors of letters are classified according to their highest rank attained within the Columbia University (including Barnard College and Teachers College) hierarchy by the spring of 1904. Authors of letters in both Group 1 and Group 2 (except for series D) are listed in the Personal and Corporate Name Index beginning on page 4.

The Trustees' Correspondence consists of letters authored not only by Barnard College, Teachers College, and Columbia University trustees, but associate members of all three boards.

The Administrators' Correspondence consists of letters authored by Barnard College, Teachers College, and Columbia University presidents, deans, provosts, bursars, secretaries, et al., but not the chairmen of academic departments, whose letters are filed in the ensuing series.

The Faculty Correspondence consists of letters authored not only by Barnard College, Teachers College, and Columbia University faculty, but instructors of any rank.

The General Correspondence ranges in subject matter from individual requests for information on admissions to explanations of student absences; from requests for information from sister educational institutions to sales solicitations and other correspondence received from vendors, both engaged and prospective. Authors of letters in this series are not included in the Personal and Corporate Name Index. Because the subject, corporate name, and personal name indices for this series have yet to be completed, it is difficult to find particular items within it. However, certain notable items encountered in passing are listed in Appendix 5.

Group 2: Arrangement

The letters are arranged in four series:

- A. Trustees' Correspondence, 1889 to 1904
Arranged by author's surname, and then chronologically.
- B. Administrators' Correspondence, 1889 to 1904
Arranged by author's surname, and then chronologically. For certain authors with large volumes of correspondence, letters are also subdivided according to surname of principal recipient--the only case in which the recipient is pertinent to filing scheme. Within alphabetical subdivisions, all correspondence is arranged chronologically.
- C. Faculty Correspondence, 1889 to 1904
Arranged by author's surname, and then chronologically.
- D. General Correspondence, 1889 to 1904
Arranged chronologically by academic year (July 1-June 30), then by author's surname, and then chronologically.

APPENDIX 1:
Files A-O

[compiled by Pat Ballou, 1982; re-edited by Donald Glassman, 2003; and June Reich, 2005]

These, together with the Trustees', Administrators', Faculty, and General correspondence, are the oldest records in the Archives. Their arrangement predates the establishment of the Barnard Archives; until 1974 they were kept in the Bursar's vault.

File A Correspondence of Ella Weed, Chairman of the Academic Committee, and Elizabeth O. Abbot, Secretary of the College, dealing with such academic matters as the appointment of instructors and, to a lesser extent, with finances. Dates: 1889-1891 and n.d.

File C Chiefly trustees' correspondence, committee reports, and Treasurer's reports dealing with the charter and with finances. Other matters of interest include Emily Smith Putnam's resignation and addresses by Silas B. Brownell, Chairman of the Board of Trustees, 1904-1917, and Nicholas Murray Butler. Dates: 1888-1911 and n.d. (MICROFILMED.)

File D Records in this file are in poor condition, many unusable. A number have been retyped from the fragments. Their principal contents deal with amendments to the Charter and By-laws, reports of trustee committees, and examinations. Dates: 1889-1897 and n.d.

File E Documents tracing the process of establishing the College: the petition and memorial to the Trustees of Columbia University, their resolution of approval, reports of the Barnard College Executive Committee, 1889-1894, early bulletins, etc. Dates: 1888-1908 and n.d.

File F Business records connected with the building of Fiske and Milbank Halls; samples of printed forms used for fund raising under Jacob Schiff, Treasurer, 1889-1896; minutes of the Academic Committee, 1894-1897.

File G A file of fragile materials in plastic enclosures too long for Files A-F.

File J This was originally bound as the record book of Frederick Wait, Clerk of the Board of Trustees, 1900-1902. Noteworthy correspondence deals with the appointment, installation, and early administration of Laura D. Gill and with the John D. Rockefeller gift of 1902.

File J1 There is no evident focus to this file, but important elements include detailed academic data (reading lists, schedules, statistics) for 1890-1891, Treasurer's reports for 1889-1890, and Trustees' reports for 1889-1894.

File K This deals largely with gifts, including the Anderson and Brinckerhoff gifts, bequests, and real estate. Dates: 1892-1918 and n.d.

- File L Correspondence, chiefly addressed to Brownell or Wait. The largest groups of letters are those from George A. Plimpton, Treasurer, 1893-1936, and Seth Low, President of Columbia University, 1889-1901. Noteworthy topics include 343 Madison Ave., Milbank Quadrangle, the Agreement of 1900, and the appointment and resignation of Deans Gill and Putnam. Dates: 1889 to 1904 and n.d.
- File M Financial records: Undergraduate tuition and fees, 1894-1900; expenses paid by the college, 1892-1897; securities held, 1898 and 1908-1937.
- File N Financial records: College income and expenses, 1894-1901; cash books, 1894-1911.
- File O Official records: Matriculation certificates, 1898-1901; mailing lists, 1890-1903; room applications for Fiske Hall, n.d.

NOTE ON ACCESS: The principal means of access is the printed box lists for the 13 files. Documents other than letters have also been card-catalogued under broad subjects (finances, buildings and grounds, scholarships, gifts). Letters from 1889 to 1904 are indexed by author in the Personal and Corporate Name Index (above).
