\* Most of the listed are classrooms but there also a few other types of rooms such as studios, labs, or presentation/event spaces.

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

**Video via Monitor** - video playback is displayed on a monitor screen

**Video/Data via Monitor** - video and computer output are displayed on a monitor screen

**Video/Data via Projector** – video/computer output are projected onto a wall screen. **m = multi-standard:** VCR handles US (NTSC) and many of the international signal formats (PAL, SECAM, etc.)

**Slide Projection** - 2"x2" carousel slide projector or comparable alternative equipment for slide projection

**Overhead Projection** - 3M overhead projector for display of transparencies

**Document camera** - high-resolution video presenter that can project all types of media (e.g. book, object) through a monitor or data projector

**CD** - Compact Disc player

**Laserdisc** - Laserdisc player

**DVD** - DVD player / **m = multi-regional** : DVD handles US (region 1) discs and many of the other world regions and PAL format

**Cassette** - audiocassette player

**Screen** - wall or tripod screen(s); p indicates portable tripod screen

**In-room Sound** - amplification of sound through wall- or ceiling-mounted speakers

**PC** - in-room computer with floppy disk, CD or DVD-ROM, USB port, and network connection, some with additional zip drive

**Network Jack** - network jack is available for a computer brought to the room (user must also provide data projector where not available in room)

**Laptop-ready** - a user-provided laptop may be connected to the in-room display system (projector or monitor) and to the network

**SCOLA** - receives programming from SCOLA, the non-profit organization that transmits international television programs for educational use via satellite

**Other:** live voice recording - class or presentation may be audiotaped from the lectern using in-room microphones  
wall mounted video cameras - class or presentation may be videotaped from the lectern using in-room cameras  
assisted listening - plug-in enhanced hearing device can be accommodated
