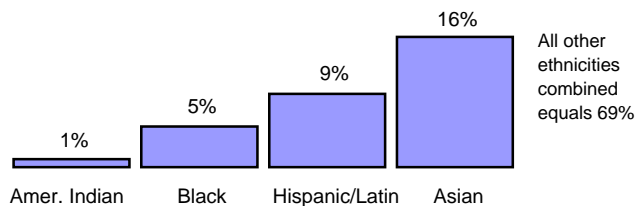

Enrollment - 2007-08 Academic Year

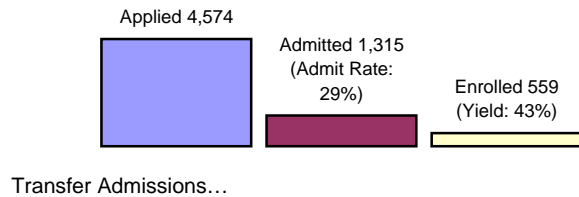


Diversity - 2007-08 Academic Year

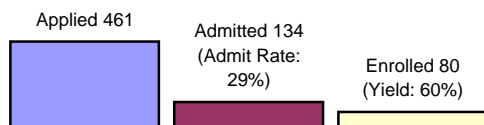
(total enrollment)



Admissions - Class of 2011



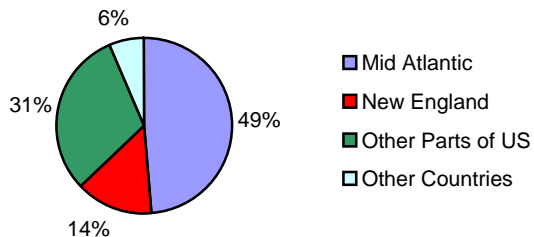

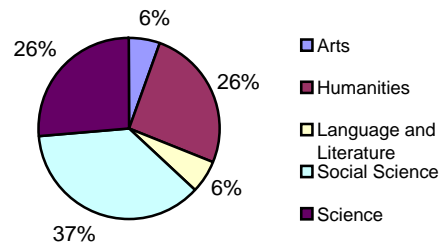

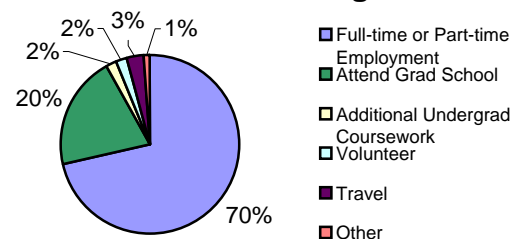
Top 5 Majors - Class of 2006

Degrees by Area - Class of 2006



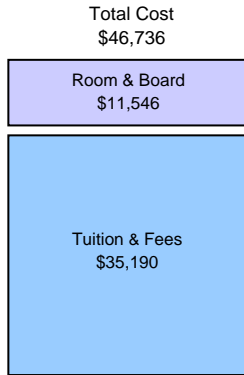
What Graduates Are Doing - Class of 2006

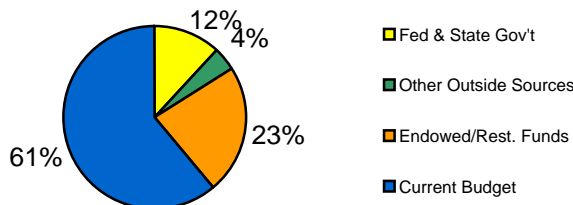

2006-07 Sources of Financial Aid



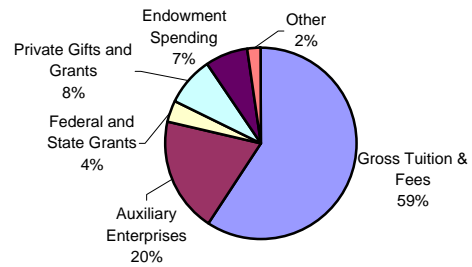
Average Loans Owed at Graduation

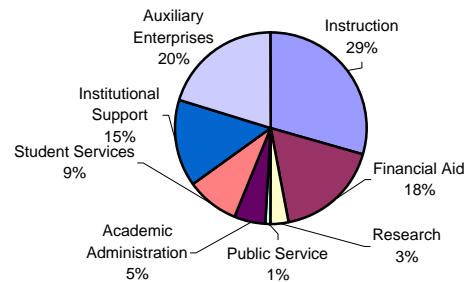

Gross Operating Expenses, 2006-07



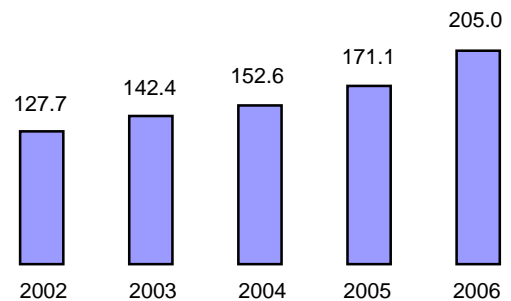
Instructional Expenditure per Student
