A Barnard student may take two semesters of music lessons, one course per term, unrestricted at Juilliard, *or* MSM, *or* Columbia. With concurrent or previous enrollment in and the satisfactory completion of two courses in theory, literature, or history of music in the third and fourth semesters of lessons, she may take and receive credit for a total of six semesters of instrumental instruction. Only a music major or minor, or a Barnard-Juilliard joint degree candidate, may take music lessons for more than six terms.
